BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project was authorized in the 1980-81 Capitol Improvement Budget. The Resolution of Necessity for the acquisition of these parcels, Resolution No. 81-286, was adopted April 21st, 1981. A private appraiser has established the value for these parcels.

There are funds in Gas Tax Fund 2106 for the estimated acquisition cost of \$35,500.00.
