

# RESOLUTION No. 42

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

March 27, 1942

PG&E BUS LINE HEARING

- - - - -

WHEREAS, the rapid urban development and sudden increased use of street cars and buses, due to tire shortage, have created a perplexing transit problem, duplicated in many cities of the nation; and


WHEREAS, the Utility Company has had an order placed for additional equipment for sometime, but due to war priorities cannot secure any guarantee of early delivery; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Committee of the City Council in its investigation is now in the process of and requires further time to secure material data upon which to determine its recommendation with reference to all phases of the bus line system in the City of Sacramento.

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THAT hearing of application of Pacific Gas & Electric Company for franchise to operate all of its bus lines in the City of Sacramento, filed with the City Council on date of January 27, 1939, be further postponed to hour of 8 o'clock P.M., on date of May 1, 1942.
