SUBJECT: Development of the Zacharias Addition to Seymour Park

SUMMARY

The proposed 1980-81 fiscal year Capital Improvements Budget includes a project to develop the Zacharias park site addition to Seymour Park to be funded by a fifty percent matching grant from the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund. It is necessary that the City Council approve application for that grant before the application deadline of July 1, 1980.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The property was acquired in fiscal year 1973-74 under a fifty percent matching grant from the Land and Water Conservation Fund. Since residential development in the area has been occurring apace, it is now necessary to develop the park site to meet the recreational needs of the neighborhood. Public meetings are being held to involve the citizens in the planning process.

FINANCIAL DATA

The total estimated cost for the project is \$248,000. The City proposes to apply for \$124,000 in LAWCON funds to be matched by \$86,400 in Park Development Funds and \$37,600 from the State Roberti-Z'berg Urban Open-Space and Recreation Block Grant Program.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, authorize

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR
LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUNDS FOR THE
DEVELOPMENT OF THE ZACHARIAS ADDITION TO SEYMOUR PARK**

WHEREAS, the Congress under Public Law 88-578 has authorized the establishment of a Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant-In-Aid Program, providing matching funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for acquiring lands and developing facilities for public outdoor recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation is responsible for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, said adopted procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications and the availability of local matching funds prior to submission of said application to the State; and

WHEREAS, the proposed development of the Zacharias addition to Seymour Park is consistent with the California Outdoor Recreation Resources Plan; and

WHEREAS, the project must be compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions immediately surrounding the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application for Land and Water Conservation Fund assistance; and
2. Certifies that said agency has matching funds from local funding sources and can finance 100 percent of the project, half of which will be reimbursed; and
3. Certifies that the project is compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions immediately surrounding the project; and
4. Appoints the City Manager as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, billing statements, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
