

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-547

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

MASTER AGREEMENT WITH THE LOS RIOS COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

BACKGROUND

- A. On June 30, 1998, the City Council granted the Sacramento Police Department (SPD) authority to enter into the first master agreement with the Los Rios Community College District for vocational training (Resolution No. 98-319, City Agreement No. 98-102).
- B. The SPD entered into a new agreement beginning July 1, 2005 (City Agreement No. 2005-1050) mistakenly under the authority of Resolution No. 98-319 to provide instruction for a period of three years with an option for extension up to two years and has been acting pursuant to the Agreement.
- C. The Sacramento Police Department anticipates running three intensive police academies, two CSO/Recruit academies as well as providing in-service training to approximately 800 sworn and non-sworn employees in the upcoming fiscal year.
- D. The agreement with Los Rios Community College District helps offset the additional expenses incurred by operating the academies. Additionally, by collaborating with Los Rios Community College District, students attending the academy and other department training gain college credit.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: City Agreement No. 2005-1050 is ratified, and the City Manager, or a designated representative, is authorized to sign all agreements and documents on behalf of the Sacramento Police Department, including any extensions or amendments thereto, with the Los Rios Community College District to provide vocational training services.
- Section 2: The City Manager, or a designated representative, is authorized to receive revenue and expend up to \$675,000 from Los Rios Community College District through the existing E-894 program.


