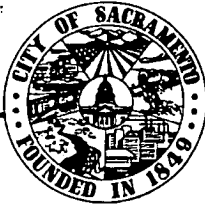

SUBJECT: Revocable Encroachment Permit - Various Water Quality Test Well Sites

SUMMARY

The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers has applied for a Revocable Encroachment Permit for the purpose of drilling approximately 25 water quality test wells on City property, in the vicinity of McClellan Air Force Base. Exact locations for each have yet to be determined. The Director of Public Works recommends that he be granted authority to negotiate and approve each separate site.

BACKGROUND

The location of this request consists of an area within one mile of all sides of McClellan Air Force Base. The wells will remain in place as long as is necessary to assure permanent water quality in the vicinity.

RECOMMENDATION

The Director of Public Works recommends that the attached Resolution be passed granting a Revocable Encroachment Permit to the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers in the area and for the purpose outlined above.

RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT TO:

U. S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of installation, maintenance and periodic inspection of water quality test wells

is hereby granted to the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, whose address is as follows: 650 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California.

The encroachment area is described as follows:

The encroachment will consists of approximately 25 sites, each site to be agreed upon by the Director of Public Works. Each site to be conditioned as per size and shape of encroachment.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 81-845 dated November 17, 1981, except Articles 18, 21 and 22, regarding Liability and Insurance substituting Article 24 as follows: The Grantors shall not be responsible or liable for injuries to persons or damage are caused by or result from the Government's (permittee's) use of the premises under the terms of this agreement and are not due to the negligence of the Grantors and the hereinafter specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Risk Management and Insurance Division of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.
