

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0087

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 26, 2019

Directing Filing of Annual Reports for City of Sacramento Assessment Districts Fiscal Year 2019/20

BACKGROUND:

- A. The City Council established the following districts under the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (part 2 of Division 15 in the Streets and Highways Code, beginning with Section 22500) (the 1972 Act), and has previously levied assessments on property within the districts to pay for landscaping and lighting maintenance services and related services to be provided within the districts, all in accordance with the 1972 Act:
1. Citywide Landscaping and Lighting District,
 2. Village Garden Landscape Maintenance District No. 2011-01,
 3. Power Inn Road Maintenance District 2003-01,
 4. Neighborhood Landscaping District, and
 5. Neighborhood Lighting District.
- B. The City Council established the following districts under Chapter 3.124 of the Sacramento City Code (Chapter 3.124), and has previously levied assessments on property in the districts to pay for maintenance and related services to be provided within the districts, all in accordance with Chapter 3.124:
1. Willowcreek Maintenance Assessment District No. 98-03,
 2. Northside Subdivision Maintenance District,
 3. Laguna Creek Maintenance District, and
 4. Neighborhood Water Quality District No. 2003-03.
- C. The maintenance and lighting Districts (collectively, the Districts) listed in Sections A and B above are each required to submit an annual engineer's report describing, among other things, the services to be provided, the cost of providing services, and the special benefit derived from maintenance activities by each parcel paying the assessment.
- D. There are no proposed new improvements or any substantial changes to existing improvements funded by the Districts for Fiscal Year 2019/20.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1 The City Council finds and determines that the background statements A through D are true and correct.

- Section 2 The Supervising Engineer of the Department of Public Works, designated by Council as the Engineer of Work for the Districts, is hereby directed to file updated annual reports to the City Clerk for the Districts in accordance with the provisions of the 1972 Act and Chapter 3.124.

- Section 3 This resolution is adopted pursuant to Section 22622 of the Streets and Highways Code and Section 3.124.190 of the Sacramento City Code.
