RESOLUTION APPROVING NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR

OAK PARK COMPLEX - PHASE II

WHEREAS, on May 19, 1982, R. H. Parker, the Environmental Coordinator of the City of Sacramento, filed a Negative Declaration with the County Clerk of Sacramento County for the following proposed City initiated project: OAK PARK COMPLEX - PHASE II

WHEREAS, the prescribed time for receiving appeals has elapsed and no appeals were received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. That the proposed project OAK PARK COMPLEX - PHASE II will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. That the Negative Declaration for the above-described project is hereby approved.
3. That the above-described project is hereby approved for the purpose of the development of 10+ acres including grading, drainage, irrigation, paths, play area, fencing, planting of turf and trees, security lighting and a 42' x 33' amphitheater.
4. That the Environmental Coordinator is authorized to file with the County Clerk a Notice of Determination for said project.
