SUBJECT: Change Order No. 1 for Additional Work Required in Connection with
J-K Alley Sewer and Water Reconstruction, 11th and 13th Streets

SUMMARY:

In accordance with the Change Order Policy adopted on November 18, 1980, this report is submitted to inform the City Council of the issuance of the subject Change Order. The Change Order was in the amount of \$6,881.20 and was issued for additional work resulting from conflicts with existing utilities and structures in connection with the J-K Alley Sewer and Water Reconstruction project, 11th and 13th Streets. The Change Order was issued to prevent added delay in the construction of the project and the additional work was performed on a time and material basis.

BACKGROUND:

The subject contract called for the reconstruction of the water and sewer lines in the J-K alley from 11th to 13th Streets. Because of the presence in the alley of a plethora of utilities and the necessity of maintaining water and sewer service to the area throughout the construction period, it was necessary to issue a Change Order to cover items as follows:

1. Stand-by time, caused by conflicts with various utilities, amounting to \$781.92.
2. Additional sewer work, caused by conflicts with utilities and maintenance of service, \$1,137.68.
3. Additional water system work, caused by the same problems, \$3,184.28.
4. Additional materials needed to construct the water system to accommodate conversion to the new main, \$1,777.32.

FINANCIAL:

The original contract was in the amount of \$89,851.50. This Change Order amounts to \$6,881.20. Funds were available in the project to cover this amount.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report is for Council information only and does not require any action.

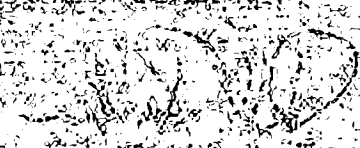
