**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ANNEXING PORTIONS OF BROADWAY, 6<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE, 53<sup>RD</sup> AND 55<sup>TH</sup> STREETS INTO THE U.C.D. MEDICAL CENTER RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Broadway and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 53<sup>rd</sup> to 55<sup>th</sup> Streets, and 53<sup>rd</sup> and 55<sup>th</sup> Streets from Broadway to 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Council District 5.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to annex portions of Broadway, 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 53<sup>rd</sup> and 55<sup>th</sup> Streets into the U.C.D. Medical Center residential permit parking area.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends annexing portions of Broadway, 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 53<sup>rd</sup>, and 55<sup>th</sup> Streets into the U.C.D. Medical Center residential permit parking area (Exhibit A). Regulating parking on these streets will relieve the parking congestion generated by medical center employees and make it easier for residents to park near their homes.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The U.C.D. Medical Center residential permit parking area was established in August 1980.
- Parking congestion is increasing on some street adjacent to the medical center and residents are having difficulty parking near their homes.
- Area residents have petitioned to be annexed into the U.C.D. Medical Center residential permit parking area.
- Residents and their guests will be exempt from the parking restrictions when the proper permit is displayed.
- A letter was sent to all of the area residents that will be impacted which outlined the request and solicited comments. There is no opposition to the proposal.
- There is adequate off street employee parking.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The cost to implement the recommendation regulation is estimated to be \$1000 for the installation of parking regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**


This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.



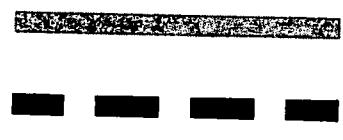

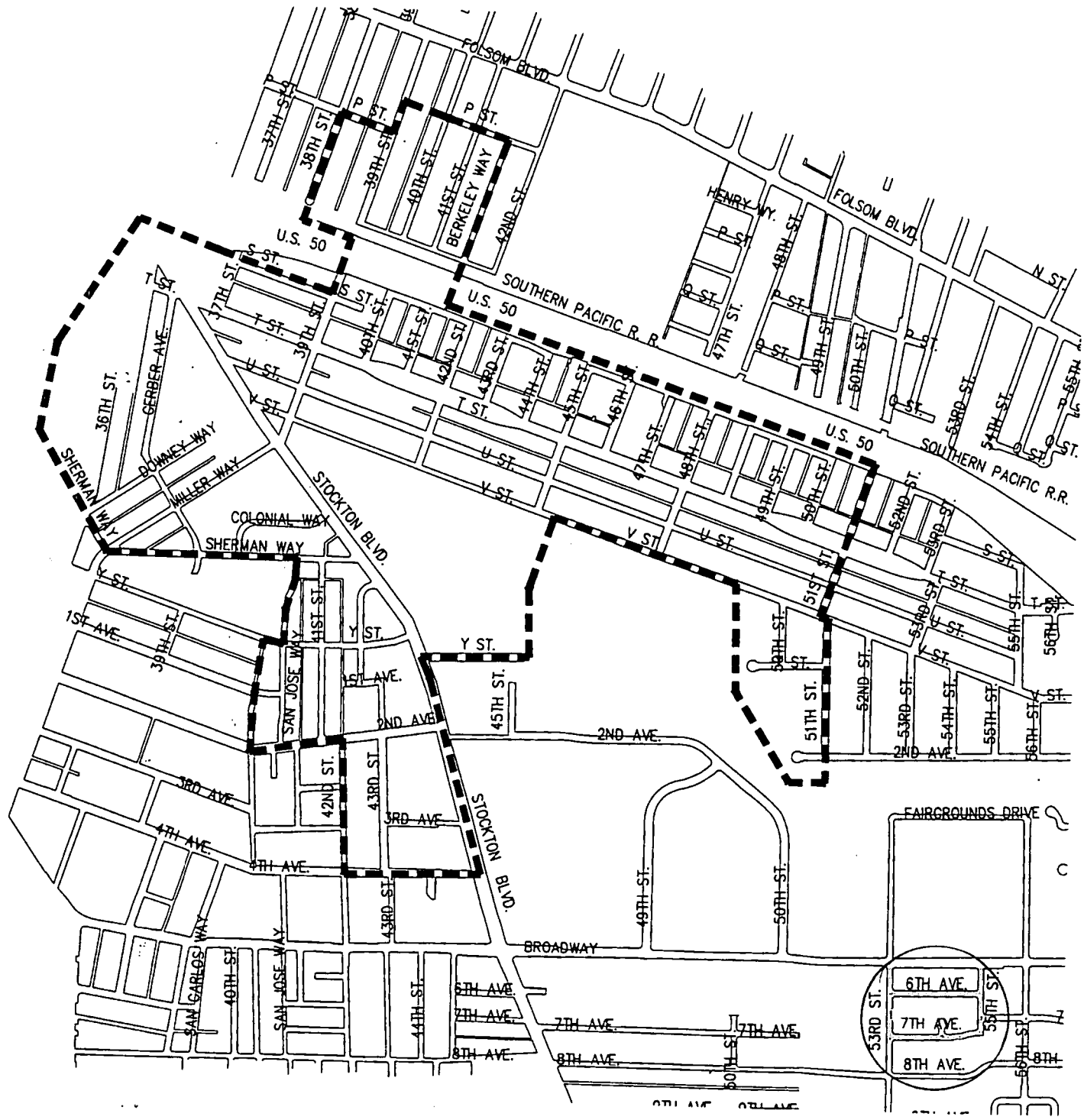

### A RESOLUTION ANNEXING PORTIONS OF BROADWAY, 6<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE, 53<sup>RD</sup> AND 55<sup>TH</sup> STREETS INTO THE U.C.D.MEDICAL CENTER RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 25.10.186 of the Sacramento City Code, whenever the City Council finds that residential streets adjacent to a residential permit parking area have all day, on-street parking congestion, then upon recommendation of the Parking Manager, such residential streets may be added to said residential permit parking area.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The following streets shall be regulated with two hour parking except with "B" permit from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m, except Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays:

- Broadway, south side, from 53<sup>rd</sup> to 55<sup>th</sup> Streets.
- 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, both sides, from 53<sup>rd</sup> to 55<sup>th</sup> Streets.
- 53<sup>rd</sup> Street, both sides, from Broadway to 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- 55<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, from Broadway to 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
