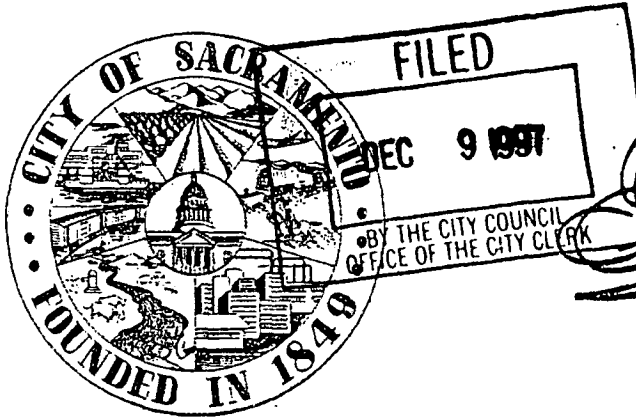

## Commending Fire Captain David Kevin

**W**HEREAS, on November, 2, 1996, Captain David Kevin witnessed a motor vehicle accident on the freeway which resulted in a pickup overturning, landing on its right side with gasoline spilling from the ruptured tank and a woman trapped inside; and

**W**HEREAS, Captain David Kevin attempted to open the driver's door to free the woman and due to the damage and gasoline burning on the ground around the vehicle he was unable to do so, and tore the rear window out with his bare hands and removed the woman from the vehicle; and

**W**HEREAS, upon insuring the woman was safely away from the dangers of the fire, Captain David Kevin helped push another vehicle away from the burning pickup.

**W**HEREAS, on May 12, 1997, Firefighter Kurt Dittig was fishing and witnessed a family (one adult male and two small children) playing in the water; and

**W**HEREAS, as the family played they worked their way into deeper water and were swept away in the current but the adult worked diligently to keep the children's heads above water; and

**W**HEREAS, Firefighter Dittig promptly dove into the water and swam to the family taking one of the children to a boat that had arrived to help, and then assisted the adult, who was overcome with exhaustion, into the boat.
