SUMMARY:

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On February 3, 1981 the City Council approved plans and specifications for Sacramento Boulevard Widening, Phase II and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on February 24, 1981. Bids received are as follows:

FINANCIAL:

In F.Y. 1977/78 the City Council approved in the Engineering Department's Budget \$720,000.00 of Community Development Block Grant funds for the Sacramento Boulevard Widening project. Total amount currently available for the subject project, as of February 20, 1981, is \$379,665.83. The estimated construction cost was \$230,352.50.
