Resolution

of the City Council

Recognizing the 1997/98 Community Action Grant Recipients as Participants in the Stormwater Management Program

WHEREAS, in the Spring of 1997, the City of Sacramento Department of Utilities Stormwater Management Program appropriated \$10,000 in grants to fund community action projects which would improve the quality of local creeks, rivers and watersheds within the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the Community Action Grant Program is part of the Stormwater Management Program's effort to establish working partnerships with the local community and foster environmental stewardship to assist in pollution prevention goals; and

WHEREAS, there were a total of four 1997/98 grant recipients, each awarded \$2,500 to implement its grant proposal; and

WHEREAS, the *North Sacramento Urban Creeks Council* received grant funds to be used to support the volunteer storm drain stenciling program, to recruit volunteers for the Council's water pollution prevention efforts, to enhance the Council's water pollution prevention and creek wildlife display, and to support community outreach efforts through participation in six north area community events and the Great American River Clean-up and Creek Week '97.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby congratulate the *North Sacramento Urban Creeks Council* and commend them for their dedication and commitment to the quality of life for Sacramento residents.
