

RESOLUTION No. 160

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

April 4th, 1929

WHEREAS, on the 30th day of August, 1916, Joseph Burns granted to the City of Sacramento an easement over the Easterly ten (10) feet of Lot Number Twenty (20) situated in Monte Vista, in the City of Sacramento, for purpose of laying and maintaining a sewer therein; and

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of September, 1916, F. Drumheller and Mary Drumheller granted to said City an easement of the easterly ten (10) feet of Lot Number Nineteen (19) of said tract for same purpose; and

WHEREAS, said City acquired these easements simply as an alternate route for said sewer because it was having trouble in securing rights of way for the sewer as contemplated; and

WHEREAS, said rights of way difficulties were adjusted and the sewer built on the other route; and

WHEREAS, said City will never build a sewer in the easement herein mentioned acquired thirteen years ago, and said easements are useless to said City,

NOW, THEREFORE, this Council declares that it has and does hereby abandon said easements above described.
