**RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE
CITY OF SACRAMENTO APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE REPORT
TO THE CITY COUNCIL ON THE PROPOSED SIXTH AMENDMENT
TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR ALKALI FLAT
REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT, SUBMITTING SAID REPORT
AND PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CITY COUNCIL, AND
CONSENTING TO A JOINT PUBLIC HEARING ON
SAID REDEVELOPMENT AMENDMENT**

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento (the "Agency") has prepared a proposed Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan (the "Redevelopment Plan") for the Alkali Flat Redevelopment Project (the "Sixth Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 33352 of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 et seq.), the Agency has prepared a Report to the City Council on the proposed Sixth Amendment); and

WHEREAS, Section 33355 of the Community Redevelopment Law authorizes a joint public hearing on the proposed Sixth Amendment with the consent of the Agency and the City Council of the City of Sacramento;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The Agency hereby approves and adopts the Report to the City Council on the Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Alkali Flat Redevelopment Project and hereby submits said Report, together with the proposed Sixth Amendment for the Project, to the City Council.

Section 2. The Agency hereby consents to a joint public hearing on the proposed Sixth Amendment, and requests the City Council to call a joint public hearing of the Agency and the City Council on Tuesday, June 20, 2000, at 7:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, to consider and act upon the proposed Sixth Amendment and all documents and evidence pertaining thereto.
