## Recognizing the Northeast Area Transportation Study Stakeholder Working Group

**WHEREAS**, the Stakeholder Working Group (SWG) representing affected agencies and jurisdictions, neighborhood associations, business groups, and other transportation interest groups was formed to work with City and consultant staff to define the area transportation problems; and

**WHEREAS**, the SWK is a voluntary group of people who donated their time to participate in a process that had value to each of them and who felt their efforts would help the City in developing an effective transportation system for the study area; and

**WHEREAS**, the group had first hand knowledge of transportation problems, diversity in opinions, generated many great project ideas and demonstrated commitment to the process as evident by consistent attendance by the vast majority; and

**WHEREAS**, during this year-long process, there were four community workshops, one public meeting, several bus tours, monthly meetings, meetings with councilmembers and meetings with interested groups; and

**WHEREAS**, as the result of all this hard work, the SWG defined the transportation problems in the study area, developed project evaluation criteria, identified projects that could solve the problems, and prioritized projects for the City's subsequent project development processing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby commend those who participated in the Northeast Area Transportation Study Stakeholder Working Group and thank them for their commitment and dedication to the Sacramento community.
