

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2009-032**

Adopted by the Redevelopment Agency  
of the City of Sacramento

May 26, 2009

### **NORTH SACRAMENTO BROWNFIELDS PROGRAM**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento ("Agency") adopted the North Sacramento Redevelopment Plan ("Redevelopment Plan") and Five Year Implementation Plan (2005-2009) for the North Sacramento Project Area ("Project Area").
- B. The Five Year Implementation Plan (2005-2009) provides for eliminating barriers to redevelopment through remediation of toxic contamination of potential development sites in the Redevelopment Area.
- C. In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and its implementing regulations, the establishment of a Brownfields Program is exempt from CEQA per Guidelines Section 15306, which exempts data collection, research and resource evaluation activities that do not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The establishment of the North Sacramento Brownfield Strategy allowing the Agency to conduct Phase I and Phase II Environmental Site Assessments (ESA) in the redevelopment area in its effort to eliminate blight is approved.
- Section 2. The Executive Director, or her designee, is authorized to amend the budget to allocate \$500,000 of North Sacramento Tax Increment funds to the North Sacramento Brownfield Strategy.




