SUBJECT: Tennis Court Resurfacing Projects

SUMMARY

Bids for resurfacing four tennis courts have been received over the approved budget allocation. Funds are available in the Quimby Act Reserve Fund for these projects. A budget amendment is required.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The FY 1984-85 CIP budget approved resurfacing tennis courts at four park sites. Bids have been received over the budget allocation as follows:

McKinley Park	\$18,000	\$16,781	\$4,019	-----	\$ 2,800
Hall, Curtis, Cabrillo	15,000	17,712	4,488	\$2,800	10,000

In order to award the resurfacing projects, funds must be transferred to these project budgets. General funds may be transferred from the Hall/Curtis/Cabrillo project to the McKinley Project (\$2,800) and the \$10,000 deficit on the Hall/Curtis/Cabrillo project may be funded by Quimby Act funds available for Hall and Curtis Parks. Funds are available in the Quimby Act Reserve Fund.

FINANCIAL DATA

Total costs of each project are: McKinley Park, \$20,800; and Hall/Curtis/Cabrillo, \$22,200. Based on bids received, the projects are under budget by \$2,800 and \$10,000, respectively. It is recommended that \$2,800 in General Funds is transferred from the Hall/Curtis/Cabrillo project to the McKinley Park project and that \$10,000 is allocated from the Quimby Act Reserve Fund to the Hall/Curtis/Cabrillo Parks project.
