

RESOLUTION No. 708

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS the City Clerk has presented to the City Council on date of July 22nd, 1937 a Referendum Petition signed by more than Five Hundred verified electors of the City of Sacramento, together with Certificate of Verification of Signatures by the County Clerk of Sacramento County, requesting submission to The People of the City of Sacramento at the Regular Municipal Election to be held on date of November 2nd, 1937, of Ordinance No 740, 4th Series, adopted by the City Council on date of June 3, 1937, entitled as follows:

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO THE PARKING OF VEHICLES UPON SUCH PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS; PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION, OPERATION, MAINTENANCE, SUPERVISION, REGULATION AND CONTROL OF THE USE OF PARKING METERS; DEFINING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING METER ZONES UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS; DECLARING AN UNLAWFULLY PARKED CAR TO BE A NUISANCE; PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; that the foregoing Ordinance be submitted to the people of the City of Sacramento at regular election to be held on said date of November 2nd, 1937, in accordance with foregoing petition and that the City Clerk be and he is hereby directed to make the necessary provisions for placing said question upon the ballot at forthcoming election.
