

RESOLUTION No. 106

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

October 4th, 1928

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that hearings before the City Planning Commission on Tentative Report, Zoning Ordinance and Plans prepared by said Commission dividing City into Districts for purpose of zoning industries, businesses, trades, apartments, dwellings and other uses; regulating height and bulk of buildings, area of yards and open spaces, be and the same are hereby set as follows:

FIRST HEARING: Monday, October 15, 1928. Council Chamber

All property north of R Street (Old and Annexed Territory will be considered.

SECOND HEARING: Tuesday, October 16, 1928. Council Chamber.

All property south of R Street lying west of 30th Street and Franklin Boulevard, respectively, will be considered.


THIRD HEARING: Wednesday, October 17 1928. Council Chamber.

All property south of R Street lying east of 30th Street and Franklin Boulevard, respectively, will be considered.

All hearings to be held at hour of 8 o'clock P. M.
