RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FUNDS FROM THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS the City of Sacramento desires, through funding made available from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program to supplement law enforcement services;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

- 1. The City Manager of the City of Sacramento, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Sacramento, to accept Federal JAG funds in the amount of \$369,139 including any extensions or amendments thereof, to supplement law enforcement services, and purchase equipment for public safety.
2. The Grant Operating Expense and Revenue budgets shall be amended as follows:
