Recognizing 524 Mexican Restaurant

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento has determined that economic development is one of its highest priorities and has adopted an economic agenda which has as a key element the retention of existing businesses with an emphasis on small business; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to recognize businesses which have thrived and contributed to our local economy; and

WHEREAS, 524 Mexican Restaurant was founded thirty years ago and is today in the same location with future plans to renovate the historic building; and

WHEREAS, Jose Gomez, Anamaria Gomez, Concepcion Gutierrez and Yolanda Gutierrez are currently the owners of 524 Mexican Restaurant and have owned the restaurant for the past seven years; and
