### BACKGROUND

The North Sacramento area's water system has been substandard since the City has taken over operation and maintenance. In order to provide better water pressures for fire protection and as part of our plan to bring surface water to this area in the near future, this large diameter distribution main is needed.


FINANCIAL DATA

This project was budgeted in the 1977-78 fiscal year budget for the Division of Water & Sewers for \$176,000.00 of which \$173,679.00 remains. Therefore, an amendment to this budget will be necessary to cover the amount of the lowest responsive bid (\$213,470.00). \$39,791 will be transferred from Water Fund (4-13) to Water Distribution Capital Improvement, 4-13-3030-1571-4820. 
RECOMMENDATION


