

Sacramento, Calif.,
May 19, 1927.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at 2 o'clock P. M., in the office of the City Manager, City Hall, President Nathan presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Chenu, Mason, Nathan.
ABSENT: None.

City Manager H.C.Bottorff also was present by invitation.

Minutes of special meeting of April 19, 1927, were read and approved as read.

The Secretary reported that there had not been sufficient time to invite Mr. H. E. Kneeland to appear before the Board in reference to his Civil Service status, and it was the decision of the Board that Mr. Kneeland be invited to appear at the next meeting.

Questions for promotional examinations for Detective Sergeant and Desk Sergeant were submitted to the Board for review.

Upon motion by Commissioner Chenu, seconded by Commissioner Mason, and unanimously carried, these questions were approved and the following dates fixed for examinations:

Detective Sergeant, 7.30 P.M. Tuesday, May 31st,
at Sutter Junior High School.

Desk Sergeant, 7.30 P.M., Wednesday, June 1st,
Council Chamber in the City Hall.

Subjects and weight for each examination were fixed as follows:

Rules & Duties, 4; Spelling, ½; Penmanship, ½;
Arithmetic, 1; Georgraphy, ½; Civil Government, ½;

Physical, 1; Personal Fitness, 2; Total, 10.

After reviewing the service record of Patrolman S. N. Richards, upon motion by Commissioner Chenu, seconded by Commissioner Mason, and unanimously carried, it was decided that he had not had the necessary three years service with the department and was therefore ineligible to take the promotional examination for Detective Sergeant. The Secretary was instructed to so notify Patrolman Richards.

Applications from Police and Fire departments for an increase in salary scales were discussed at some length by the Board, after considering tabulated comparative statement of salaries paid by other California cities, and other data relating to the subject.

It was decided to invite committees from the Fire and Police departments to meet with the Board to discuss this question on Tuesday, May 24th, at 4 o'clock P. M.

Adjournment was taken at 3.40 o'clock P. M.
