**AGREEMENT TO COOPERATE WITH THE
SACRAMENTO REGIONAL COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT
IN ROUTING OF THE LOWER NORTHWEST INTERCEPTOR
ALONG THE RD 900 ALIGNMENT**


WHEREAS, the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District has determined the need to design and construct the Lower Northwest Interceptor by 2007 to continue to provide reliable service to areas in the northern part of Sacramento County; and

WHEREAS, the implementation schedule for the Lower Northwest Interceptor requires that the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District proceed with adoption of a preferred alignment and development of environmental studies for the preferred and alternative routes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento and the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District support the RD 900 Route for the Lower Northwest Interceptor consisting of the RD 900 segment north of the Barge Canal in West Sacramento and the West Sacramento segment south of the barge Canal; and


WHEREAS, the RD 900 route would appear to minimize disruption to the cities of Sacramento and West Sacramento.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO that the City Council will support the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District Lower Northwest Interceptor route in Yolo County along the RD 900 alignment, and request that the County Regional Sanitation District work with the City on a public process to define the Natomas/City of Sacramento portion of the alignment.
