

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-332

DETERMINING THE RESULT OF THE SPECIAL MAILED-BALLOT ELECTION HELD ON MAY 2, 2006, WITHIN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS MAINTENANCE COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 2002-02, ANNEXATION NO. 14

BACKGROUND:

- A.** The City Clerk has duly canvassed the votes cast by the qualified electors within the City of Sacramento Neighborhood Parks Maintenance Community Facilities District No. 2002-02, Annexation No. 14, (Annexation No. 14) at the special mailed-ballot election held within Annexation No. 14 on May 2, 2006, upon the proposition set forth below.
- B.** The City Clerk has certified to the City Council the result of the votes cast at the special mailed-ballot election upon the proposition, and the certification is now on file in the City Clerk's office.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The statements in paragraphs A and B of the Background are accurate.

Section 2. At the special mailed-ballot election, the following proposition was submitted to the qualified voters of Annexation No. 14:

Measure (A): Shall the City of Sacramento Neighborhood Parks Maintenance Community Facilities District No. 2002-02, Annexation No. 14, be authorized to finance neighborhood parks maintenance, more fully described in Exhibit A, and shall an appropriations limit in the amount of \$70,000 per fiscal year in connection therewith be established for the maximum rate and method of apportionment as provided in Resolution No. 2006-264 adopted by the City Council on April 18, 2006, which is incorporated herein by reference, and a tax be levied to pay for the maintenance of neighborhood parks.

Section 3. The canvass of the votes cast at the special mailed-ballot election held in Annexation No. 14 on May 2, 2006, as shown by the City Clerk's certification, is approved and confirmed.
