

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-274

AWARD CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE COLOMA COMMUNITY CENTER FIRE ALARM SYSTEM UPGRADE PROJECT (LW86, L13000500)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Coloma Community Center currently has an older, heat detector-based fire alarm system. Upgrading to a smoke detector-based system will provide earlier warning to the occupants of the community center in the event of a fire. Additionally, the recommended upgrade is in compliance with the current City of Sacramento Fire Code.
- B. The formal bid process for the construction of the Coloma Community Center fire alarm system upgrade was completed on April 9, 2008. Pursuant to City Code Section 3.60.020, it was determined that Simplex Grinnell L.P. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The construction plans and specifications for the Coloma Community Center Fire Alarm System Upgrade Project are approved and the construction contract is awarded to Simplex Grinnell L.P., the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, in an amount not to exceed \$155,000.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the construction contract with Simplex Grinnell L.P.


