Transfer of Funds to the Transportation Corridor Program (R15190000)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Transportation Corridor Program (R15190000) includes an annual pavement preservation strategy that applies slurry seal treatments to street surfaces which extends the useful life of the pavement.
- B. The project also incorporates complete street enhancements when possible to improve neighborhood livability by improving safety and encouraging walking and biking.
- C. Additional funds are needed to complete design and bid advertisement of the fiscal year 2019 project.
- D. The total estimated cost to complete design and bid advertisement of the annual pavement resurfacing project is \$300,000.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to transfer \$200,000 (Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account Fund, Fund 2036) from the expense budget in the Street and Bikeway Overlay and Seals Program (R15182000) to the expense budget in the Transportation Corridor Program (R15190000).
