AGREEMENT WITH CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, SACRAMENTO – FACILITY USE

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento, Department of Parks and Recreation, Access Leisure and Paralympic Sport Club Programs seek to enter into an agreement with California State University, Sacramento (CSUS) in order to provide a number of sports opportunities for children, teens, and adults with disabilities using the premier facilities at CSUS.
- B. This agreement will renew the City's ongoing relationship with the University and its students.
- C. This agreement will create a staff presence on campus to identify, train, and recruit CSUS students to serve as volunteers for a number of the City's ongoing programs.
- D. This agreement does not fall within the City Manager's signature authority.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a one-year memorandum of understanding and up to two, one-year renewals with California State University, Sacramento (CSUS) to allow the City of Sacramento to use facilities at CSUS to operate sports programs through the City's Access Leisure and Paralympic Sport Club Programs at no cost to the City.


