**SUBJECT: ICG TELECOM GROUP, INC. (ICG) AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE  
THE RIGHT TO USE CITY OWNED CONDUITS**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT: 8<sup>th</sup> and I Streets to 16<sup>th</sup> and L Streets - -  
District 1**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. Approve and authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement (on file with the City Clerk's Office) with Intel Communications Group, Inc. (ICG) for the use of conduits located within the City for installation of fiber optic communications cables.
2. It also recommends that in consideration of the conduit use, the City accept exclusive right to use 24 single and 24 multi-mode strands of ICG owned fiber optic cable. In addition, ICG will install approximately 4100 feet of City owned fiber optic cable at no cost to the City.

**SUMMARY:**

A fifteen-year Agreement has been negotiated with ICG for use of the above-referenced conduit in exchange for providing the City with exclusive right to use 24 strands of single-mode and 24 strands of multi-mode ICG owned fiber. In addition ICG will install, at no cost to the city, approximately 4100 feet of City owned fiber optic cable in City owned conduits.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

In August 1996, ICG approached City Staff on the possibilities of a joint communications project. ICG suggested that they were willing to install fiber optic cable for city use in exchange for use of City conduits along the way. ICG presented an existing agreement with the City of Oakland as a model. After several exploratory meetings it was decided that a shared use agreement would be beneficial to both parties. City and ICG staff worked out an agreement and plans for the joint project were drawn. The project will connect the following downtown City facilities:

1. Computer Services
2. 13<sup>th</sup> I Building
3. Convention Center
4. Panatoni Building
5. Police Administration Building
6. City Hall/existing fiber to other downtown city offices.

The fiber optic cable will be configured, as a protected ring so that a cut or damaged cable will continue to operate.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The agreement will benefit the City by providing fiber cable connections to the City's main downtown facilities for LAN interconnection and the cable includes additional capacity for future growth. Also, avoidance of the estimated construction costs of \$200,000.00 if undertaken as a separate City project.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

Council action in adopting this resolution is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) because it will have no conceivable effect on the physical environment.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**


This action of approving the conduit agreement for the telecommunications cable is consistent with the City Council's stated policy of encouraging public and private cooperation where common needs can be identified.


