Schedules A, B, C, D, E, F, G & H are applicable to your disclosure categories.

**CATEGORY 1.**

Interests in real property located in the jurisdiction.

**CATEGORY 2.**

(a) Investments in any business entity of the type which, at the time relevant to when a disclosure statement must be filed under this Code, is contracting or within the past two years has contracted with the City of Sacramento to provide services, supplies, materials and equipment to the Fire Department. The phrase "services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment" includes by way of example only and without limitations the following:

- (1) business entities which perform construction or engineering work or services for the department or provide consulting services to the department;
- (2) business entities which manufacture or sell materials, supplies or equipment used in the suppression of fires; and,
- (3) business entities which manufacture, sell, lease, or service motor vehicles and parts thereof, and petroleum products.

(b) Any source of income, including gifts, from:

- (1) any business entity described in subdivision (a) above; and,
- (2) any person with an ownership interest in a business entity described in subdivision (a) above or who is employed by such a business entity.

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CATEGORY 3.

- (a) Investments in any business entity engaged in building construction subject to regulation under the City of Sacramento Building Code, Fire Prevention Code, Electrical Code, Plumbing Code, Division 12 of the California Health and Safety Code, or Title 19, 24 or 25 of the California Administrative Code.
- (b) Any source of income, including gifts, from:
  - (1) any business entity described in subdivision (a) above; and,
  - (2) any person with an ownership interest in a business entity described in subdivision (a) above or who is employed by such a business entity.

CATEGORY 4.

- (a) Any investment in a business entity engaged in the manufacture or supply of building materials to business entities engaged in building construction and subject to the regulation specified in category 3 above.
- (b) Any source of income, including gifts, from:
  - (1) any business entity described in subdivision (a) above; and,
  - (2) any person with an ownership interest in a business entity described in subdivision (a) above or who is employed by such a business entity.

CATEGORY 7.

A designated employee in this category shall disclose his or her status as a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or any position of management held in any business entity, an investment in which is required to be disclosed under categories 1-6 above.
