

HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
NOVEMBER 13, 1952

The regular time of canvassing having fallen on a legal holiday and no quorum having been present on date of November 12, 1952, the Honorable City Council met at hour of 10:00 o'clock P. M. as a Board of City Election Canvassers pursuant to provisions of the City Charter, the Annexation Act and the Elections Code to canvass the result of the vote cast by Precincts at Special Municipal Election held on date of November 4, 1952 on the Proposition of annexing the "Sutterville Heights Area" to the City of Sacramento, in accordance with Resolution No. 142, adopted July 24, 1952.

Mayor Wood presiding and roll call was answered by members of the Council:

The canvass of said vote then proceeded with the following vote:

The City Clerk reported 50 applications for Absentee Voting, of which 4 had not been returned with 3 of latter number being "War Voters" applicants.

Pursuant to the Elections Code granting 16 days for the return of "War Voters" Ballots, Councilman Hicks thereupon presented the following resolution moving its adoption:

RESOLUTION NO. 237

WHEREAS, Pursuant to provisions of the Charter and The Annexation Act of 1913, the City Council has met as a Canvassing Board at Regular Meeting of the City Council held on date of November 13, 1952 and thereupon canvassed the Returns of the eleven (11) precincts of the Sutterville Heights Annexation Area Election held on date of November 4, 1952; and

WHEREAS, up to the hour of said Regular Meeting on this date at least three absentee "war voter" ballots still remain unreturned to the City Clerk,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council as a Canvassing Board recess until hour of 7:00 o'clock P. M. on date of November 20, 1952 in order to permit all absentee ballots to be returned in accordance with the Elections Code and the canvass of said election completed.

Seconded by Councilman Nielsen and carried by the following vote:

At 10:20 o'clock P. M. the City Council thereupon recessed in accordance with foregoing resolution.
