SUBJECT: Alkali Flat Redevelopment Area Determination of Eligibility
Draft

SUMMARY

In compliance with federal regulations, Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and Executive Order 11593, the City of Sacramento has caused the preparation of a report identifying individual buildings, streetscapes and districts potentially eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. Three copies of the draft report are on file in the City Clerk's office for Council's review. This data is being presented to Council for information only. The report will be submitted to the state and federal governments for review and acceptance, and will then be used by the City as a planning tool in the redevelopment process of Alkali Flat. The completion of this report meets one of the federal requirements for the release of CDBG funds.
