Recognizing Richard H. Hoffelt

WHEREAS, Richard Hoffelt, of Wilke, Fleury, Hoffelt, Gould & Birney, has distinguished himself in the general practice of law, concentrating in corporate, business and real estate transactional matters and litigation with particular emphasis in the healthcare field during his 42 years of practice; and

WHEREAS, Richard is the recipient of numerous awards including the Health Care and the Law Award bestowed by the Health Care Law Section of the Sacramento County Bar Association and honored as Lawyer of the Year in 1997 by the Sacramento County Bar Association; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hoffelt has served as a pro tempore judge and arbitrator for Sacramento County Superior Court since 1976, is a member of the Court's Arbitration Policy Committee, as well as serving as a judge pro tempore and arbitrator for the Superior Courts of El Dorado, Solano, Yuba, Amador and Calaveras Counties; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hoffelt is past president of the Sacramento County Bar Association, founding member and early president of the Barristers Club of Sacramento, member of the Executive Committee of the California Association of Local Bar Associations, and delegate to numerous conventions of the California State Bar Association, member of the American Bar Association, the California Bar Association and the Sacramento County Bar Association; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hoffelt has also served for years upon the Board of Directors of the American Heart Association, served six years upon the Board of Directors of the Children's Receiving Home of Sacramento as Chairman of the Board of Governors of Shriners Hospitals for Children Northern California, and played a major role in moving the hospital to Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hoffelt was elected to the Sacramento County Republican Central Committee in the 1950's and served as its temporary chairman for the purpose of its organization at that time and provided Governor Ronald Reagan's administration in California in 1967 with pro bono legal services in the formation of the nonprofit corporate entity "Governor's Survey on Efficiency and Cost Control".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby commend Richard Hoffelt for his community commitment and for his service and dedication to the betterment of others.
