SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF SUPPLEMENT NO. 1 TO CITY AGREEMENT 93-136 THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL RADIO COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM LICENSING AGREEMENT

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the execution of Supplement No. 1 to City Agreement No. 93-136 with County of Sacramento on the Sacramento Regional Radio Communications System (SRRCS) Licensing Agreement to reflect certain organization changes within the County of Sacramento.

SUMMARY:

There is a continued need to retain participation in the SRRCS. The radio system provides public safety and local government radio service in a common system with other neighboring local governments. The SRRCS exemplifies the City's cooperative service arrangements with other local governments in order to reduce costs while improving community services. This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute Supplement No. 1 to City Agreement No. 93-136

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- In October 1993, the City Council approved a Resolution Authorizing the City Manger to execute Agreements with the County of Sacramento for the Sacramento Regional Radio Communications System (SRRCS).
- Today the SRRCS provides public safety and local government radio service to over 7000 users in the City and County of Sacramento and to the Cities of Folsom and West Sacramento, the Sacramento Regional Transit District, the Sacramento Regional Fire/EMS Communication Center and other local agencies.
- SRRCS is a valuable resource for the Sacramento Region and exemplifies the City's desire to cooperate with other local governments in order to reduce costs while improving community services.
- Within the Sacramento Regional Radio Licensing Agreement the System Manager was defined as the Director of General Services for the County of Sacramento.
- In 1998 certain organizational changes within the County of Sacramento changed the definition of the Director of General Services.

The purpose of this supplement is to change the Sacramento Regional Radio Licensing Agreement to reflect the recent organizational changes within the County of Sacramento. The continued services of SRRCS are needed to provide ongoing public safety and local government radio service to the City of Sacramento. It is therefore proposed that the City execute Supplement No. 1 to the Agreement No. 93-136.


