RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE REASONABLE COSTS AND FINDINGS OF FACT FOR WEED ABATEMENT WORK AS SHOWN ON LIST PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 13 SECTION 39500 ET SEQ OF THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE AND PLACING A LIEN ON THE PROPERTY BY THE CITY FOR THE COSTS THEREOF

WHEREAS, heretofore the City Council by resolution No. 82-035, set a public hearing for February 2, 1982 in the City Council Chamber to hear and consider all protests, if there be any, and then affirm or reject the placing of the costs of weed abatement work upon the described real property as a lien, and

WHEREAS, notice of the time and place of said hearing was given in the manner provided by law, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a hearing thereon and it was established by competent evidence that in each case the work had been performed by private contract.

WHEREAS, the City Council has found the total cost for each such work to be a reasonable cost, and no protests either verbal or written were made:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. That the reasonable costs for weed abatement work was and is the sum set forth in aforementioned list.
2. That, as provided in Section 39577 of the California Government Code, the City of Sacramento is entitled to and hereby attaches a special assessment lien upon the described property and attaches upon recordation in the Office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento.
3. That the City Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the County Recorder.
