

RESOLUTION No. 760

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, on December 5 1939, the City of Sacramento entered into a contract with McGillivray Construction Company for asphaltic concrete mixture, and

WHEREAS, although this mixture was for the Store Department and was designed to meet the requirements of the City for this material for the entire season, the amount was fixed at 2,000 tons, although the specifications contained the words "more or less", and

WHEREAS, the tonage required exceeded the 2,000 tons by an amount which costs \$1,030.02,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said excess amount purchased under said contract over and above the 2,000 tons, is hereby ratified, confirmed, and approved.
