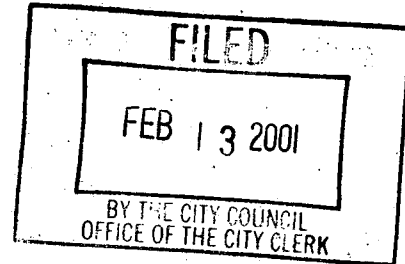

SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF CHANGE ORDER NO. 2 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,559.56 FOR DOS RIOS STREET RECONSTRUCTION (PN: TT21)

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Dos Rios Street between Richards Boulevard and North 12/ North B Street, Council District 1.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$2,559.56 with Baldwin Contracting.

SUMMARY:

The construction contract for the Dos Rios Street Reconstruction Project was awarded to Baldwin Contracting on March 21, 2000 in the amount of \$465,739. Change Order No. 1 compensated the contractor for installing geotextile fabric over excavation of unsuitable soil, extra sewer work, repairing damaged storm drain and water mains, and repairing some existing frontage improvements. Change Order No. 2 will compensate the contractor for accommodating additional field conflicts.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$90,817.42 compensated the contractor for placing geotextile fabric, removing and replacing unsuitable material, repairing some existing storm drain and water pipes, raising a sewer maintenance hole, relocating a fence, and a general increase of items to complete contract work.

Approval of Change Order No. 2 will compensate the contractor for additional roadway, curb, gutter and sidewalk work.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- As of January 18, 2001, the Dos Rios Street Reconstruction Project has \$68,790 which is sufficient.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, the Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the proposed project. This review has result in the determination that the proposed project will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and a Categorical Exemption was prepared.



This change order is consistent with Title 3 of the Sacramento City Code.



ESBD goals were achieved when construction contract was awarded.


