BUDGET DISCUSSED re STATUS.

Commission directed that Chairman, by letter, advise the City Manager of their concern and interest in their budget request and offer to meet with him re: same.

URBAN AESTHETIC COMMITTEE:

After considerable discussion of the problem of improving community appearance, the Commission appointed a committee to work with any and all groups and persons on programs to improve the appearance of the Community.

LANDSCAPE TRAFFICWAYS:

The Commission directed that a letter be forwarded to the City Traffic Engineer (copy to Council Traffic Committee) requesting a cost estimate report on a plan to eliminate black top islands at the Freeport-Sutterville Road traffic interchange in a manner similar to the work the State of California has done on Freeport Boulevard median strip.

URBAN RENEWAL COMMITTEE:

The Commission discussed the need for a continuing Urban Renewal program and felt that a committee was needed to work with the administration and general public to carry ahead with this phase of City Planning activity.

CORDOVA TOWNSITE ZONING PLAN:

The Commission discussed and reviewed planning and zoning developments. Based on this discussion, a revised plan is to be prepared and returned to the Commission for further discussion.
