**MEMORIALIZING RESOLUTION PRESENTED TO JENNETTE BRUCE
IN MEMORY OF WILLIAM H. BRUCE**

It is hereby noted that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of William H. Bruce on the 10th day of November, 1980, at the age of 47, in Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, William H. Bruce was a 26-year resident of Sacramento, and served as a Captain with the Sacramento Fire Department, where he worked for twenty-one years; and

WHEREAS, William H. Bruce was a member of the Board of Directors of the Sacramento Economic Opportunity Council, and was a Coach with the Parochial Athletic Little League, a member of the Christian Brothers LaSalle Club and served as Chairman of the Credit Committee of the City Employees Credit Union; and

WHEREAS, William H. Bruce was the husband of Jennette Bruce and the father of Emily J., Douglas J., and Stephen J. Bruce;

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes, and the official records of the City, record the passing of William H. Bruce, and has caused this Resolution to be prepared.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which this meeting shall be called adjourned in respect to the memory of William H. Bruce.
