SUBJECT: STATE HIGHWAY PROJECT -- Freeport Blvd.
Limited Access Highway, Blair Avenue
South to End of Project beyond Florin Road.

MEMBERS IN SESSION:

When the Division of Highways improved the section of Freeport Boulevard from Blair Avenue north to Sutterville Road at Land Park the median strip was given a minimum landscape treatment wherever the Division felt it possible.

The result is one of the more attractive commercial streets in the Sacramento area. When the abutting commercial property owners see the light by taking steps to improve their properties in a like manner, the efforts of the Division of Highways will be fully justified. At that time the shopping area will be truly unique locally.

In the meantime, it is hoped that the Division of Highways will continue their initial effort and develop an even more extensive landscape development southward to the end of the project.

With this in mind, the Commission is urged to recommend that the City Council make such a request to the Highway Division Officials. Such a project would be in keeping with the high quality of public and private development in the southwest sector of the City.
