

RESOLUTION No. 2060.
APPROVING PLANS AND GRADES

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of


February 18, 1926.

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, that the Plans presented by the City Engineer for the improvement of 50th Street from the northerly line of 8th Avenue to a point 110 feet north of the north line of 7th Avenue; 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue, from the easterly line of Stockton Boulevard to the easterly line of Boulevard Terrace (as the same is shown on the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California); Stockton Boulevard from the northerly line to the southerly line of said Boulevard Terrace; Right-of-way between 7th and 8th Avenues from the easterly line of Stockton Boulevard to the easterly line of said Boulevard Terrace; right-of-way along the east line of Lot 112 of the said Boulevard Terrace; right-of-way along the north line of Lots 113 to 151, both inclusive, in said Boulevard Terrace; and rights-of-way along the north and south sides of 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue, from the easterly line of Stockton Boulevard to the easterly line of the said Boulevard Terrace; in the City of Sacramento; be and the same are hereby approved and adopted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the grades shown on said plans be and the same are hereby declared to be the official grades.
