

RESOLUTION No. 6

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, on January 26, 1940, the City of Sacramento entered into an agreement with Shell Oil Company granting said company the right to maintain gasoline service equipment at the Municipal Airport, for which privilege the Shell Oil Company was to pay to the City of Sacramento one (1) cent per gallon on all gasoline and five (5) cents per gallon on all oil sold at the Airport each month, and


WHEREAS, the Sacramento Municipal Airport, under the program of National Defense, has been taken over by the U. S. Army Air Corps, and said gasoline and oil is now sold to the U. S. Army Air Corps exclusively, under contract between the Shell Oil Company and the U. S. Army Air Corps, and

WHEREAS, conditions have so changed that the spirit and intent of said contract no longer apply,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, that the City waives the payment of the above mentioned sums, for the duration of the war between Germany, Japan and Italy, and the United States.
