U.S. CENSUS**

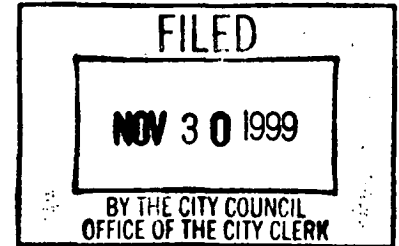
