

RESOLUTION No. 809

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
November 12, 1937

WHEREAS, a Consolidated Regular and Special Municipal Election was held in the City of Sacramento on the 2nd day of November, 1937, pursuant to provisions of Ordinance No. 752, Fourth Series adopted by the City Council on date of October 7th, 1937, at which a certain proposed Proposition for the incurring of bonded indebtedness against the City of Sacramento was submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the vote and returns of said election have this day been canvassed by the City Council of the City of Sacramento convening as a Canvassing Board and the results thereof duly ascertained.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED that the total number of votes cast by the electors at said election for and against the following Bond Proposition, being the only Bond Proposition submitted to the voters at such election; viz:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED that the total number of votes cast in favor of foregoing Proposition were and are respectively less than the required two-thirds of the total vote cast on said Proposition and that the electors of said City did thereby determine that the City of Sacramento should not incur aforesaid bonded indebtedness

ADOPTED by the City Council on date of November 12th, 1937, by the following vote:
