

## RESOLUTION NO. 2010-523

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

August 31, 2010

### COOPERATIVE PURCHASE OF ASPHALT AND AGGREGATE MATERIALS

#### BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento, Department of Transportation, Street Services Division has ongoing requirements for asphalt and aggregate materials. To ensure the safety of citizens and others who depend upon the City's transportation corridors, it is imperative that the City not allow the maintenance and repair of those corridors to decline. Uninterrupted access to asphalt and aggregate materials is essential to the City's maintenance and repair activities. Due to the heavy demand for asphalt materials during the peak maintenance season, typically June through October, it is necessary to purchase from two vendors.
- B. Based upon the results of previous competitive bid results, Procurement Services intends to purchase cooperatively from the County contract. However, due to the timing of the County's bid process and the scope of the City's intended purchase requiring Council approval, it is estimated that there will be a two to three month gap in various City departments' ability to purchase asphalt and aggregate products.
- C. Staff recommends that City Council approve the continued use of County of Sacramento Cooperative Purchasing Agreement WA00025184 with Teichert Aggregates, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$2.5 million, and Cooperative Purchasing Agreement WA00025183 with Granite Construction Company, in the not to exceed amount of \$1.94 million, through September 5, 2010, or until such time as the contracts are no longer available. This recommendation complies with City Code section 3.56.240, which allows for the use of approved cooperative contracts through other government jurisdictions or public agencies without separate competitive bidding.

#### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The use of Cooperative Purchasing Agreement WA00025184 between the County of Sacramento and Teichert Aggregates for the purchase of asphalt and aggregate materials is approved for a not-to-exceed amount of \$2.5 million.
- Section 2. The use of a Cooperative Purchasing Agreement WA00025183 between the County of Sacramento and Granite Construction Company for the use of asphalt and aggregate materials is approved for a not-to-exceed amount of \$1.94 million.


