**BACKGROUND**

Regents of the University of California has requested a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of constructing a telecommunication system to connect buildings occupied by the UCD Medical Center. This system will be constructed in a joint trench with SMUD and Pacific Bell. See Exhibit "A".

Sacramento City Code, Chapter 12, Section 12.70 states that Council may by resolution grant permits revocable at its will for minor or temporary purposes or privileges on public property subject to such terms and conditions as it deems necessary for the public interest. The use of the property by the permittee shall constitute his acceptance and agreement to be bound by the terms and conditions of the permit.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

The standard permit fee of \$200.00 has been paid by the applicant. The project does not involve any cost to the City. The project is privately financed by Regents of the University of California.



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a Revocable Encroachment Permit be granted to Regents of the University of California, for the construction of a telecommunication system at UCD Medical Center.

This encroachment is described as follows:

Stockton Boulevard, beginning approximately 450 feet north of 3rd Avenue 3030 feet to a point on the northerly line of 39th Street; and from Stockton Boulevard right of way lines, on the following streets:

the southerly half of Sherman Way approximately 35 feet west; east on Y Street to the easterly line of 45th Street; and the easterly half of 39th Street from Stockton Boulevard to the northerly line of V Street; and V Street from the easterly line of 39th Street to the easterly line of Stockton Boulevard.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit," which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 81-845 dated November 17, 1981. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Risk Management and Insurance Division of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. Future up-grades to water system and combined sewer, drain system may require relocation of subject facilities. This shall be done at no cost to the City and within a reasonable time frame request.
2. Applicant must belong to Underground Service Alert (USA).
3. A minimum of 6" of vertical clearance shall be provided between water mains and conduit lines.
4. All street cuts to be saw cut and repaved to standard City specifications.

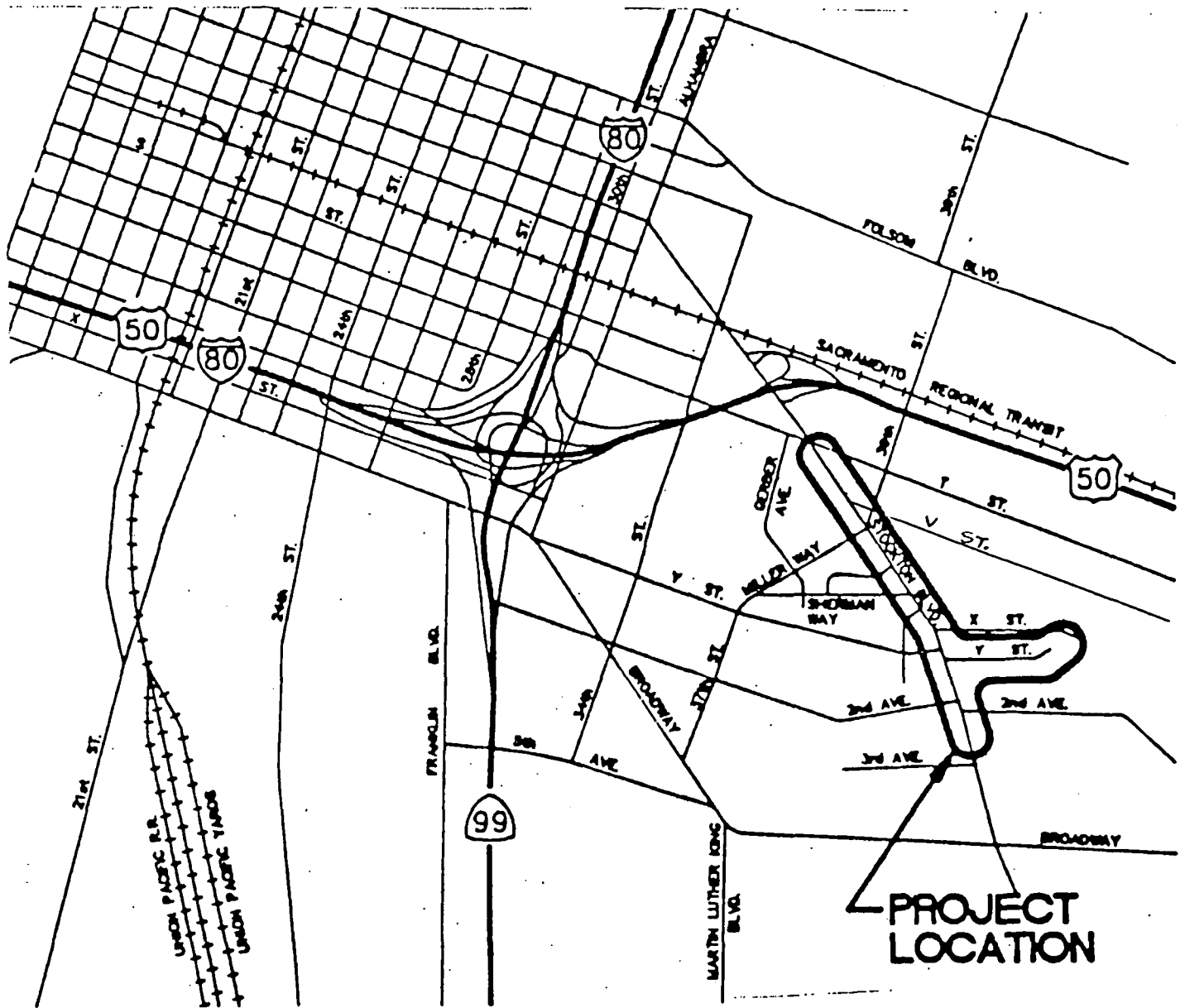
