

**A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING TRAILERS, SEMI-TRAILERS  
AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES OVER 10,000 POUNDS GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT**


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 10.36.080(A)(1) of the Sacramento City Code, any regularly employed and salaried officer of the police department of the City or any regularly employed and salaried employee of the City who is engaged in directing traffic or enforcing parking laws and regulations of the City may remove or cause to be removed: Any vehicle which is parked or left standing upon a street or highway when such parking or standing is prohibited by resolution of this City and signs are posted giving notice of such removal.

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

All trailers semi-trailers, and commercial vehicles over 10,000 pounds gross vehicle weight shall be prohibited on the north side of Massie Court from Stockton Boulevard west for 500 feet. Vehicles left standing or parked shall be towed.
