

RESOLUTION NO. 249

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

January 10, 1947

Introduced by Councilman Taylor

SEWAGE DISPOSAL NORTHEAST OF CITY

WHEREAS, the district Northeast of the City embracing Arden Acres, and adjacent territory (approximately 1800 acres) has become heavily populated and many more Subdivisions are being planned to take care of the demand for Homesites in the Metropolitan Area, and

WHEREAS, the property owners Northeast of the City are urgently in need of a modern sewage disposal system, and

WHEREAS, said persons have heretofore indicated their desire to install and finance such system and have requested the privilege of diverting their sewage through the City sewer lines, and appropriately compensating the City therefor, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineering Department in its recent comprehensive survey reports that existing facilities are adequate to handle the additional service, and

WHEREAS, approximately \$8,000,000.00 in new home construction is awaiting favorable action in this regard.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that it is the sense of the City Council that the proposed sanitary district Northeast of the City be permitted to use the City Sewer system for disposition of its sewage, subject to approval of a contract submitted to the City Council after the legal creation of said sanitary district.
