
**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE HEARING
EXAMINERS FOR APPEALS OF DEBARMENT
DECISIONS**

WHEREAS, under Section 3.60.410 of the Sacramento City Code, as amended by Ordinance No. _____ adopted by the City Council on _____, 2003, an appeal of a decision of the City Manager regarding the debarment of a contractor or the period or scope of debarment is heard by a hearing examiner from a panel of hearing examiners designated for this purpose by resolution of the City Council; and


WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to designate the panel of hearing examiners to hear appeals of a debarment decision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

1. Pursuant to Section 3.60.410 A of the Sacramento City Code, as amended by Ordinance No. _____, the attorney hearing officers provided by the Institute for Administrative Justice of the University of Pacific, McGeorge School of Law (the "Institute") to hear appeals of various other decisions by City staff and City Boards are hereby designated as the panel of hearing examiners to hear appeals of debarment decisions. When it is necessary to select a hearing officer for this purpose, the City Clerk shall request the Institute to provide an attorney hearing officer to hear the appeal and issue a decision as provided in Section 3.60.410 of the Sacramento City Code.
2. This Resolution shall become effective on the date that Ordinance No. _____ becomes effective.
