SUBJECT: Loading, Hauling and Unloading Clayey Soil From South Pocket
Lake Development to City Sanitary Landfill - Resolution
Approving Negative Declaration

SUMMARY

The Environmental Coordinator finds that this project will not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and therefore recommends that the project and a Negative Declaration be approved by the City Council.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the State EIR guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated August 1983, an initial study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the project would not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared. On July 30, 1985, the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. On August 2, 1985, Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the Draft Negative Declaration was published in the Sacramento Union. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for comments regarding the Negative Declaration, with no comments having been received.

This project will consist of loading, hauling and unloading clayey soil from the South Pocket Lake Development area to the City Sanitary Landfill at 28th and A Streets.

RECOMMENDATION

The Environmental Coordinator recommends that the attached resolution be passed which will:


1. Determine that the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment.

RESOLUTION APPROVING NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR LOADING,
